## Hearing Guidelines

In accordance with s. 78 of the *Health Professions Act*, the hearing will be open to the public unless the Hearing Tribunal accepts a motion or application to close the Hearing.

-  A hearing is open to observers. The Hearing tribunal may close a hearing or a portion of a hearing at any time. If any part of a hearing is closed, observers will be required to exit the hearing.
-  Observers must remain quiet, calm and respectful during the hearing process.
-  Observers may not bring food or drink into the hearing.
-  No phones, cameras or other recording or communication devices are permitted in a hearing room.
-  No observer is permitted to provide comment (written, verbal or non-verbal) to the Hearing Tribunal.
-  The Hearing Tribunal may request that an observer leave the hearing if the observer is disruptive or disrespectful of the hearing process.
-  There will be scheduled times when observers must leave the hearing (i.e., lunch break, during deliberations by tribunal)
-  Observers are only permitted to enter and exit a hearing during scheduled breaks. If an observer must leave at any time other than during a scheduled break, they will not be readmitted until after the next scheduled break.
