POLICY

Regulated membership

Pursuant to the *Denturists Profession Regulation* and the College of Alberta Denturists Bylaws, there are three categories of regulated membership:

- 1. general regulated member
- 2. provisional regulated member
- 3. courtesy regulated member

A general regulated member:

- may be a member of Council, if eligible as per the *Health Professions Act* (HPA) and College Bylaws
- III may be a member of a committee of the College, if eligible as per the HPA and College Bylaws
- May attend meetings of the College membership
- 🗵 may vote on matters of the College, as requested by Council
- 🗵 will receive all member communication distributed by the College

A regulated member (provisional or courtesy):

- 😰 may not be a member of Council or a College committee
- 🔯 may attend meetings of the College membership
- 🔯 may vote on matters of the College as requested by Council
- \mathbb{Z} will receive all member communication distributed by the College

Applications

- Applications for regulated membership will be assessed by the Registrar; however, applications may be referred to the Registration Committee at the discretion of the Registrar.
- An incomplete application which is inactive for a period of 180 days will be considered cancelled. The applicant must, thereafter, submit a new application and supporting documentation.

Registration tenure

- general and provisional membership must be renewed annually
- as per the regulations, the length of time a member may be on the courtesy register is a maximum of six months



Non-regulated membership

Pursuant to the College of Alberta Denturists Bylaws, there is one category of non-regulated membership:

1. student membership

A non-regulated member:

- 😥 may not be a member of Council or a College committee
- 🔯 may attend meetings of the College membership
- 😥 will receive all member communication distributed by the College

Applications

- Displications for non-regulated membership will be assessed by the Registrar.
- An incomplete application which is inactive for a period of 180 days will be considered cancelled. The applicant must, thereafter, submit a new application and supporting documentation.

Membership tenure

Student membership is for the length of time in which the individual in enrolled in an approved denturist-technology program.
